DePauw's Hertel, Wesley's Warrick and Harris, plus Guilford's Barnette Highlight 2006 Football Gazette South All-Region Team

NORTH AURORA, Illinois --Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year, **Dustin Hertel**, from DePauw University, school all-time leading passer, **Chris Warrick**, from Wesley College, and Old Dominion Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Year and two-time Regional Defensive Back of the Year **Mario Harris**, plus, **Chris Barnette**, from Guilford College, headline a talented 2006 *Don Hansen's Football Gazette NCAA Division III South All-Region team*. Wesley's, **Mike Drass**, led his charges to a second-straight semifinal finish in the NCAA Div. III playoffs, while finishing the season with a 13-1 record, was named Regional Coach of the Year.

Hertel was affirmed the Defensive Lineman of the Year, while Warrick declared the Offensive Back of the Year Award, while teammate Harris was chosen the Defensive Back of the Year, and Barnette claimed the Offensive Receiver of the Year Award. Senior, **Josh Knox**, from Hardin-Simmons University earned Offensive Lineman of the Year accolades, while, **Ben Scott**, from Johns Hopkins University claimed the Special Teams Player of the Year award. The University of Mary Hardin-Baylor's, **Jerrell Freeman** is the Linebacker of the year.

Hertel a senior, from Batesville, Indiana, is the Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference Defensive player of the year. Hertel set a school and SCAC record single-season tackles for loss (27.5) and tied SCAC and set DePauw single-season record for sacks (16) in 2006. He ranks second in NCAA Division III for tackles for loss, third for sacks and fourth in forced fumbles. His complete stats for 2006 are, 85 total tackles, including 27.5 tackles for loss (-155 yards) with 16 sacks (120 yards). Hertel also caused five fumbles, recovered three, had three pass breakups, returned his interception 15 yards for a touchdown and blocked a field goal attempt.

Warrick, a senior, from Avon Grove, Pennsylvania, was named the Atlantic Central Football Conference Offensive Player of the Year. Warrick became Wesley's all-time career leading passer with over 9,700 yards and 103 touchdowns. As a starter he has led his team to a 39-9 record. For the 2006 season he completed 274-of 391 passes for 3,321 yards and 33 touchdowns, while being intercepted just nine times. He also scored three rushing touchdowns.

Harris, a senior, from Annapolis, Maryland, is a two-time first-team selection to the American Football Coaches Association All-American team. Harris also repeats as the Football Gazette Defensive Back of the Year. In 2006 he registered 81 tackles (49 solo), including 4.5 tackles for loss (-25 yards), one fumble recovery for 11 yards, 12 pass breakups, two interceptions for seven yards and blocked one kick.

Barnette, a senior, from Semora, North Carolina, was named the Old Dominion Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the year. He is also a first-team AFCA selection. He averaged 9.4 catches per game, including 94 receptions in 2006. Barnette concluded his career as Guilford's receptions leader with 266 catches for 2,953 yards and 30 touchdowns. For the 2006 season he caught 94 passes for 900 yards and scored nine touchdowns.

Knox, a Senior, from Snyder, Texas, was named the American Southwest Conference Offensive Lineman of the Year and was selected a first team American Football Coaches Association All-American. He paved the way for an offense that averaged 40.6 points per game and 463.8 total yards per game. Knox was also selected to play in the Aztec Bowl.

Scott, a senior, from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, is a first team All-Centennial Conference selection as well as an AFCA All-American, and was selected to play in the Aztec Bowl. Scott, besides being a first team Region selection at Punter for the Football Gazette, is also

a third team selection at Place Kicker. Scott ranked fourth in the nation in punting average (41.6) and tied for third in field goals per game (1.3). He was the only player in the nation at any level who ranks in the top five in both categories. Scott holds nine school records for kicking and punting. In 2006, he punted 53 times for 2,204 yards and a 41.6 yards per punt average. He converted on 13-of-19 field goal attempts, with a long of 52 yards.

Freeman, a junior, from Waco, Texas, was named to the AFCA All-American team and is a first team Southwest Athletic Conference member. He led his team in tackles, tackles for loss and interceptions. He was also the only player in the ASC to be chosen Player of the Week twice during the season. His stats for 2006 are, 96 tackles (51 solo), including 16 tackles for loss (86 yards) with 5.5 sacks (64 yards). Freeman also caused two fumbles, recovered one fumble and returned it 29 yards for a touchdown, broke up five passes and had four interceptions with seven return yards.

Mike Drass has led the Wolverines to a record of 110-38-1 in 14 seasons as the head coach. Drass was named American Football Monthly Division III Coach of the Year in 2006 as the Wolverines won their 2nd consecutive NCAA South Region Championship. The Wolverines defeated The University of Mary Hardin-Baylor 34-20 to advance the NCAA Semi Finals posting a 13-1 record. Coach Drass is the Executive Director of Sports and Recreation overseeing the Athletics, Sports Medicine and Recreation. Drass was honored as the Atlantic Central Football Conference "Coach of the Year" after the '98, '00 & '01 & '05 seasons. In March of 1993 Drass was named the Wolverines third Division III coach, after spending three years as the defensive coordinator. Coach Drass and is among the Top 10 active coaches in Division III with a winning percentage of .740. Committed to success in the classroom and on the football field the Wolverines stress an academics first approach to College football. "Football at Wesley College is about a Cap and Gown, not a helmet and shoulder pads," says Drass "I get the most satisfaction when one of our players walk across the graduation stage. Our belief is simple; there can be no success on the playing field unless there is progress made toward a degree in the classroom." As a player at Mansfield University, Drass was a two-time All-PSAC as an offensive lineman and captain of the Mountaineers his senior year. Coach Drass originally hails from Glen Mills, PA and attended Penncrest High School.
